The Montessori methodology works well alongside the El Bambino's curriculum. This is because El Bambino uses Permata and KSPK as its guidance to monitor and classify the children with their natural ability and developments. El Bambino uses Montessori as it's technics of methods to help the children be more skilled, independent and responsible towards their growth. The combination focuses on the individual needs of the child, good relationships between teacher and learner, and a positive learning environment.

The right Montessori methods give benefits to the children through their emotional wellbeing that comes from making choices independently, and knowing those choices come with responsibility.

The capacity for a child to be in control of their own learning builds independence, autonomy and the ability to engage the attention for long periods of time, alongside social awareness.

Activities & Syllabus

The Montessori activities will cover 5 areas in children development:

Practical Life, Sensorial, Mathematics, Language & Cultural Studies

These are the 5 Montessori Syllabus

A child will choose and be encouraged to try 1 or many activities within each of these syllabus daily. Activities prepared are excessible to the child and prepared for their age groups.















El Bambino Classrooms

El Bambino's class and facilities are prepared with the Montessori environment and has been set up with a range of activities for children to choose what they want to do, engaging with each or just one, as long as they cover all the Montessori's Syllabus.

At El Bambino (EB) classroom, a child might do up to more than 5 Montessori activities in 3 hours, daily activity and the activities can be done alone, some with a friend, some in a small group and some with the teacher. The teacher's role is to ensure that the environment is perfectly prepared, with everything ready for children to use to support their spontaneous choice. Teachers will have a broad plan of what they would like children to be engaged in, based on their individual interests, and will observe and encourage them as they take part. Through the observation teacher track progress of the child individually, rather than formal assessments and tests like conventional preschool do, and at EB homework is rarely given.

We treat children like equals, same level as the adult. The child dictates the pace of what they do day-to-day, this give them confident talking to adults, and is learning to be good at walking into a new environment and working out what their wants to explore.

As the school focuses on providing the additional activities as part of the curriculum for child development. Our open plan campus also aid with monitoring ease of young child, freedom of movement and safety.

Parents wanting to focus more on **Academic for children 4 - 6 years** should opt for our **PRESINT 11** Branch. P11 does not provide free extracurricular activities for children. However, parent's may join lessons for an extra charge. The school **focuses on the Montessori Learning** with daily Circle Time (Dancing, Singing, Yoga, etc) activities. Our larger campus offers more movement in and outside classrooms for children with safety.

Both Schools teaches using the **Montessori Methodology** and classrooms are designed for each specific age group. Authentic materials are used and provided in both branches and each school consist of age appropriate bathrooms. Mandatory Trial

Why does El Bambino Require Every Child to undergo a trial?

A Trial is necessary to help both parents and school to assess the child's readiness to begin their schooling journey, or for those that have previous schooling experience the trial benefits both child and school to assess mental and development progress.

We want to ensure we can offer the best services and outcome for your child in there education and schooling journey. The trial helps in confirming we can cater to the child positively and we hope parents can cooperate in this journey.

Payment for Trial

The Trial is Compulsory and Payable - You may refer back to the Fee Structure for further details.

A **Booking Fee** and The **Mandatory Trial Fee** is payable prior to commencement of the trial session. The fee covers for the child's care, meals and materials for the week. Parents who are interested in enrolling are requested to discuss with El Bambino's Management team on appointing a date for the trial.

A confirmation of enrolment will be announced to the parents on the last day of trial and any pending documents must be submitted and remaining fees are then payable. Kindly note that the booking fee will be transferred over as part of the registration fee.

The booking fee will not be refunded, If after the trial session a child does not get a confirmation.

Parents will receive a report at the end of the trial for your child in relation to the teachers observation.



















Registration Procedure

Kindly follow the below for process of registration:

- 1. Seek an appointment for a school tour and potential student interview or inform school management of your interest via email info@elbambino.my or phone +60 12 480 0057
- 2. Understood clearly about the school's policies and regulations within the registration form, parent handbook and parent agreement.
- 3. Payment of Booking Fee and Mandatory Trial Fee.
- 4. Placement on a waiting list pending attendance of children for Trial.
- 5. Attend the Mandatory Trial of 1 Week.
- 6. Upon notification of an opening and confirmation of enrolment, Handover and completion of forms and documents, payment of remaining fees and collection of school kit should be made.
- 7. Completion of forms and provision of relevant documents:
 - 2 recent passport size photographs of your child/ren
 - A copy of your child/ren's birth certificate
 - A copy of your child/ren's Immunization record
 - Copy of Parents and/or children's Covid-19 Vaccination Certificate
 - Registration form duly signed and dated
 - · Acknowledgment of our parent handbook & agreement duly signed and dated
 - A list of all person who are authorised to collect your child from school with information including their photocopy identity card, car registration number and relationship to your child.
- 8. Start of the first day at school! *enrolment welcome all year round!
